Ottawa Regional Heritage Fair 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Your son/daughter has been invited to display his/her exemplary project at the Ottawa Regional Heritage Fair to be held on April 22, 2020 at the Canadian Museum of History from 9:15 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This exciting event promotes Canadian heritage in our schools by encouraging students, ranging from grades 4 to 10, to explore a topic of personal interest in Canadian history. This year, there will be 150 projects from local schools.

Local judges, both from the heritage and educational communities have volunteered to judge projects. All projects will be judged and some will be chosen to proceed to the Provincial Fair and/or considered for the Young Citizens Award.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FOR BOTH THE PROVINCIAL FAIR AND YOUNG CITIZENS ONLY ONE STUDENT MAY REPRESENT A PROJECT. THE STUDENT WHO WILL REPRESENT THE PROJECT MUST BE IDENTIFIED PRIOR TO THE OTTAWA FAIR. Please help the students come to a consensus regarding who will represent the partnership, group or team.

Please note:

Students may bring or buy their lunch at the Museum.

Balloons, water and fire cannot be part of your project.

If food is part of your project, please do not offer any to Museum visitors.

Plants or wood that you took from the outdoors are not allowed. There can be insects and these can harm some of the artefacts on display in the Museum. Wood purchased in a store or a plant from a florist is allowed.

Students are encouraged to bring a tablecloth or paper to cover their display area.

The school or students must supply multimedia equipment, excluding the power bar which will be provided by the Museum. Transportation is the responsibility of the school or parents. Parking will be available at the Museum.

Security Concerns:

Students will not be allowed to leave the building at any time. Volunteers and teachers will be in attendance throughout the day.

During the day students will have the opportunity to:

- have their projects judged in an interview by 2 judges;
- select their favorite project to be considered for the Student's Choice Award;
- participate in a workshop.

Parents and guests are welcome to visit the Fair in the Museum's Grand Hall, where the projects will be on display. They can visit the projects but are asked not to linger at their student's table. If they wish to visit the remainder of the Museum, they must pay admission fees. **Please note that judges will ask that parents not be present with the students when judging is taking place.**

Parental Consent Form and Media Release Form must be collected by the teacher and brought to the Fair on the day of the event.
